

Welcome to this 24 hour vigil of prayer in St. Mary's Church, Chapel Lane, the oldest catholic church in Belfast. We come together to celebrate the feast day of Our Lady of Fatima , and to pray for the reign of The Immaculate Heart of Mary in our beloved nation and the whole world.

The Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to three little shepherd children – Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco, in Fatima, Portugal, on the 13th May 1917 and continued to appear on the 13th of each month until October 1917, when 70,000 people witnessed the miracle of the sun. Our Lady brought a message of peace, and reparation

for sin, encouraging devotion to Her Immaculate Heart, and the daily recitation of the rosary, for the conversion of sinners and the salvation of souls.

As with other Marian apparitions, Our Lady of Fatima entrusted her message for salvation of souls to little children. In the words of Pope John Paul, “May the message of their lives live on for ever to light humanity’s way”!

The Vigil

The 24 hour vigil will start with The Angelus at 6 p.m. this evening. The vigil mass is at 8.30 p.m. tonight, followed by adoration through to 6 p.m. tomorrow, breaking for mass at 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. and finishing with mass tomorrow evening at 6 p.m.

We will pray The Rosary and The Angel Prayers every hour with a short reading from the story of Fatima, including readings from the new book on the life of Sr Lucia written by the Carmelite sisters of Carmel Coimbra.

Prayer petitions may be left in the basket on the altar of Our Lady; these will be brought to the Cova D'Iria in Fatima.

We wish to thank The Mill Hill Missionaries of St. Mary's, for hosting this vigil in honour of Our Lady, again this year.

FATIMA PRAYERS:

The prayers taught to the children at Fatima are prayers given to us from heaven, we should treasure them and include them in our daily prayers.

Pardon Prayer

Given to the children by the Angel in Spring 1916.

My God, I believe, I adore, I hope, and I love You. I ask pardon of You for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope, and do not love you. (x3)

The Angel's Prayer

Given to the children by the Angel in October 1916, when he appeared to them with a chalice and a host; drops of blood fell from the host, suspended in the air, into the chalice.

O most Holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, I adore Thee profoundly. I offer Thee the most Precious Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges, and indifference by which He is offended. By the infinite merits of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg the conversion of poor sinners. (x3)

Eucharistic Prayer

Prayed by the children, during the first apparition of Our Lady, 13th May 2017.

Most Holy Trinity, I adore You! My God, my God, I love You in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Sacrifice Prayer

On 13th July, Our Lady told the children, "sacrifice yourselves for sinners and say many times, especially whenever you make some sacrifice:

O my Jesus, it is for love of You, in reparation for the offences committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary, and for the conversion of poor sinners." (x3)

Decade Prayer

On 13th July, Our Lady told the children, after showing them a vision of hell, "When you pray the Rosary, say after each mystery:

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins; save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls into Heaven, especially those who are in most need of Thy mercy".

Promise of the Five First Saturdays

"I promise to assist at the hour of death, with the

graces for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturday of 5 consecutive months, shall confess, receive Holy Communion, recite five consecutive decades the Rosary and keep me company for 15 minutes while meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, with the intention of making reparation to me". **Our Lady**

"Many souls begin the First Saturdays but few finish them. It would please me if they did five with fervour and with the intention of making reparation to the Heart of your heavenly Mother". **Jesus to Lucia 15 Feb 1926**
