

SPIRITUAL BOUQUET TO OUR LADY OF FATIMA

100th Anniversary of Fatima,
on 13th May 2017, on behalf
of the people of Ireland

On 13th May 1917, Our Lady appeared to three little shepherd children - Lucia, Bl. Francisco and Bl. Jacinta - in Fatima, Portugal, with an important message of prayer and conversion for the world. Our Lady continued to appear on the 13th of each month until October, when 70,000 people witnessed the Miracle of the Sun; St. Joseph also appeared in the sky, holding the Infant Child in his arms, and they each made the Sign of the Cross, blessing the world.

Ireland needs to heed the message of Fatima. FATIMA PRAYERS:

The prayers taught to the children at Fatima are prayers given to us from heaven, we should treasure them and include them in our daily prayers.

Pardon Prayer

Given to the children by the Angel in Spring 1916.

My God, I believe, I adore, I hope, and I love You. I ask pardon of You for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope, and do not love you. (x3)



The Angel's Prayer

Given to the children by the Angel in October 1916, when he appeared to them with a chalice and a host; drops of blood fell from the host, suspended in the air, into the chalice.

O most Holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, I adore Thee profoundly. I offer Thee the most Precious Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges, and indifference by which He is offended. By the infinite merits of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg the conversion of poor sinners. (x3)

Eucharistic Prayer

Prayed by the children, during the first apparition of Our Lady, 13th May 1917.

Most Holy Trinity, I adore You! My God, my God, I love You in the Most Blessed Sacrament. (x3)

Sacrifice Prayer

On 13th July 1917, Our Lady told the children, "sacrifice yourselves for sinners and say many times, especially whenever you make some sacrifice:

O my Jesus, it is for love of You, in reparation for the offences committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary, and for the conversion of poor sinners".

Decade Prayer

On 13th July 1917, Our Lady told the children, after showing them a vision of hell, "When you pray the Rosary, say after each mystery:

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins; save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls into Heaven, especially those who are in most need of Thy mercy".

Promise of the Five First Saturdays

"I promise to assist at the hour of death, with the graces for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturday of 5 consecutive months, shall confess, receive Holy Communion, recite five consecutive decades of the Rosary and keep me company for 15 minutes while meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, with the intention of making reparation to me". Our Lady

"Many souls begin the First Saturdays but few finish them. It would please me if they did five with fervour and with the intention of making reparation to the Heart of your heavenly Mother". Jesus to Lucia 15 Feb 1926

"Continue to pray the rosary every day in honour of Our Lady of the Rosary". Our Lady of Fatima

"Father, to you I offer praise, for what You have hidden from the learned and the clever you have revealed to the merest children". Father, to You I offer praise for all your children, from the Virgin Mary, your humble Servant, to the little shepherds... may the message of their lives live on forever to light humanity's way!"
