## WELCOME

Welcome to everyone who has joined us this evening on the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart for this All Night Vigil in the heart of Ireland. We gather to make reparation to the most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary and, through their infinite merits, to beg the Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, for the conversion and salvation of Ireland.

Pope St. John Paul said, "Every people, every country, every diocese, has its holy places in which the heart of the whole people of God beats, one could say, in more lively fashion; places in which Christ dwells in a special way in our midst". Emmanuel House, on this ancient monastic site of St. Brendan, is a holy place and a light in the darkness. Many come here each month, seeking peace and the healing balm of Christ and to unite in prayer for Ireland. Clonfert in Irish *Chluain Feartha* means "meadow of miracles". Devotion to Our Lady of Clonfert, was long established here for centuries.

On 27 December 1673, the feast of St. John the Apostle, Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary while she was praying in front of the Blessed Sacrament in her convent in Paray-le-Monial, France. St. Margaret Mary describes the vision as: "Jesus came resplendent with glory, with His five wounds shining like so many suns. From all parts of His Sacred Humanity there issued flames but especially

from His adorable breast, which was like a furnace. Opening it, He showed me His loving and lovable Heart as the living source of those flames. Then He revealed to me all the unspeakable marvels of His pure love, and the excess of love He had conceived for men from whom He had received nothing but ingratitude and contempt. **"This is more grievous to Me,"** He said, **"than all that I endured in my Passion...you, at least, give Me the happiness of making up for their ingratitude, as much as you can."**

Jesus continued to appear to St. Margaret Mary, revealing His passionate love for all humanity and His great sorrow at the world's indifference, especially to the Sacrament of Love, and gave her the 12 promises of His most Sacred Heart. Jesus also told her, **"Announce it and let it be announced to the whole world, that I set neither limit nor measure to My gifts for those who seek them in My Heart"**.

On Thursday 16 June 1675, Jesus appeared for the last time to St. Margaret Mary while she was making a holy hour in the chapel between 11p.m. and midnight. Our Lord, revealed His heart to her and said, **"Behold the Heart, which has so loved men that it has spared nothing, even to exhausting itself in order to testify its love; and in return, I receive from their greater part only ingratitude by their irreverence and sacrilege and by the coldness and contempt they have for Me, in this Sacrament of love. But what I feel most keenly is that it is hearts which are consecrated to Me, that treat Me thus. Therefore, I ask of you that the Friday after Corpus Christi be set apart for a special Feast to honour My Heart, by receiving communion on that day, and making reparation to It by a solemn act, in order to make amends for the indignities which It has received during the time It has been exposed on the altars. I promise you that My Heart shall expand Itself to shed in abundance the influence of Its Divine Love upon those who shall thus honour It, and cause It to be honoured."**

This evening we unite to make a solemn act of reparation as our Sovereign Lord asked. We will also make reparation for the offenses caused by substitution of God's Ten Commandments by modern paganism. Sacred Heart of Jesus have mercy on us, Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us, St. Joseph pray for us. All the holy angels and saints pray for us.

### 7 P.M. STATIONS OF THE CROSS

When Jesus died on the Cross, His most Sacred  
Heart was pierced with the lance by the soldier  
Longinus who was immediately converted.  
Blessed Anne Catherine Emmerich tells us, "He  
halted on the right of our Saviour's body, grasped  
the lance with both hands, and drove it up with  
such violence into the hollow distended right side  
of the Sacred Body through the entrails and the  
heart, that its point opened a little wound on the  
left breast. When with all his force he drew the  
blessed lance from the wide wound it had made  
on the right side of Jesus, a copious stream of  
blood and water rushed forth and flowed over  
his upright face bedewing him with grace and  
salvation. He sprang quickly from his horse, fell  
upon his knees, struck his breast and before all  
present proclaimed aloud his belief in Jesus".

**Relic of the True Cross and relic of linen  
cloth that touched the lance of St. Loginus  
and St. Veronica's veil with the image of  
The Holy Face are present for veneration  
(Vatican 1933)**

When we pray The Rosary as a group, or make the Stations of the Cross or spend 30 minutes in  
Adoration, we can gain a plenary indulgence for a Holy Soul from the Treasury of the Church. We  
can gain one plenary indulgence daily. Usual conditions of receiving Holy Communion in a state of  
grace and prayer for the Pope's intentions, to include an Our Father and a Hail Mary, apply.

We are now resolved to expiate each and every deplorable outrage committed against You; we are determined to make amends for the manifold offenses against Christian modesty in indecent dress and behaviour, for all the foul seductions laid to ensnare the feet of the innocent, for the frequent violations of Sundays and holy days, and for the shocking blasphemies uttered against You and Your saints. We wish to make amends for the insults to which your Vicar on earth and your priests are subjected, by conscious neglect of terrible acts of sacrilege, of the very Sacrament of Your divine love, and lastly for the public crimes of nations who resist the rights and teaching authority of the Church which You have founded.

Would that we were able to wash away such abominations with our blood. We now offer, in reparation for these violations of your Divine Honour, the satisfaction you once made to Your Eternal Father on the Cross and which You continue to renew daily on our altars; we offer it in union with the acts of atonement of Your Virgin Mother and all the saints and of the pious faithful on earth; and we sincerely promise to make recompense, as far as we can with the help of Your grace, for all neglect of Your love and for the sins we and others have committed in the past. Henceforth, we will live a life of unswerving faith, of purity of conduct, of perfect observance of the precepts of the Gospel and especially that of charity. We promise to the best of our power to prevent others from offending You and to bring as many as possible to follow You.

O loving Jesus, through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our model in reparation, deign to receive the voluntary offering we make of this act of expiation; and by the crowning gift of perseverance keep us faithful unto death in our duty and the allegiance we owe You, that we may all one day come to that happy home, where with the Father and the Holy Spirit You live and reign, forever and ever. Amen

## Grace and Mercy

On Thursday 13 June 1929, Sister Lucia was making a Holy Hour from 11 p.m to midnight in the convent chapel in Tuy, Spain. The chaplet lit up with a supernatural light and she had a vision of The Holy Trinity, above the altar. The date was the twelfth anniversary of the second apparition of Our Lady of The Rosary, in Fatima.

Lucia said, “Suddenly the whole chapel lit up with a supernatural light and above the altar appeared a cross of light reaching the ceiling. In a brighter light on the upper part of the cross could be seen the face of a man and his body as far as the waist, upon His breast was a dove, also of light, and nailed to the cross was the body of another man. A little below the waist I could see a chalice and a large host suspended in the air. Drops of blood were falling from the face of Jesus crucified and from the wound in His side. These drops ran down onto the host and into the chalice. Beneath the right arm of the cross was Our Lady. It was Our Lady of Fatima with her Immaculate Heart, without sword or roses, but with a crown of thorns and flames. Under the left arm of the cross were large letters, as if of crystal water which ran down upon the altar and formed the words ‘Grace and Mercy’. I understood that it was the Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity”.

Lucia saw what happens at every Mass. The Grace and Mercy of God are the fruits of the Sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross, present at each Mass, which pour down on humanity. Mary is present, as at Calvary, as intercessor and mediatrix of all graces. Mary also represents the love of the Father who never gives up on His children and wants to save them. And in her right hand, Our Lady holds the Rosary, a reminder of her request in Fatima, to “**continue to pray The Rosary every day**”.

The vision is also linked to the third apparition of the Angel of Fatima in Autumn 1916. Lucia was first taught how to adore the Holy Trinity and pray in reparation to the hearts of Jesus and Mary, when she was 9 years old. The Angel of Portugal appeared to Lucia and St. Francisco and St. Jacinta, holding a chalice, with a Host suspended in the air above it, from which drops of blood fell into it. The Angel knelt with his face



to the ground and prayed: “**Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I adore Thee profoundly. I offer Thee the most precious body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifference by which He is offended. By the Infinite merits of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg the conversion of poor sinners**”.

Then the Angel said, “Take and drink the Body and Blood of Christ, horribly outraged by ungrateful men. Make reparation for their crimes and console your God”.

During the vision, Our Lady said, “**the moment has come in which God asks the Holy Father, in union with all the Bishops of the world, to make the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, promising to save it by this means. There are so many souls whom the Justice of God condemns for sins committed against me, that I have come to ask reparation: sacrifice yourself for this intention and pray**”.

On 13 June 1917, Our Lady of The Rosary appeared to the three little shepherds in Fatima for the second time. Our Lady told Lucia, “**Jesus wants to use you to make me known and loved. He wants to establish in the world**

devotion to my Immaculate Heart. To those who accept this, I promise them salvation of their souls and they will be loved by God like flowers placed by me to adorn His throne”.

Our Lady said that soon she would take Jacinta and Francisco to heaven. Lucia asked, “Am I to stay here alone?” And Our Lady replied, “**No, my daughter, are you suffering a great deal? Don’t lose heart. I will never forsake you. My Immaculate Heart will be your refuge and the way that leads you to God**”. Our Lady revealed her Immaculate heart, to the children, encircled by thorns which pierced it. Lucia said, “We understood that this was the Immaculate Heart of Mary, outraged by the sins of humanity and seeking reparation”.



On 13 July 1917 during the third apparition of Fatima, Our Lady showed the children a vision of hell and said to them, “**you have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them God wishes to establish devotion to my Immaculate Heart**”.

On Thursday 10 December 1925, when Lucia was 18 years old, she was in her room when it suddenly lit up and Our Lady appeared with the Child Jesus. The Child Jesus said, “**have compassion on the Heart of your most Holy Mother, covered with thorns with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment, and there is no one to make an act of reparation**

to remove them”.

The Our Lady said, “**Look my daughter, at my heart surrounded with thorns with which ungrateful men pierce me every moment with their blasphemies and ingratitude. You at least try and console me**”. And then Our Lady gave Lucia The Great Promise of the Five First Saturdays – “**I promise to assist at the hour of death, with all the graces necessary for salvation, all those who on the first Saturday of five consecutive months, shall confess, receive Holy Communion, recite five decades of The Rosary, and keep me company for fifteen minutes while meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary with the intention of making reparation to me**”.

On Thursday 29 May 1930, Lucia at the end of a holy hour in front of the Blessed Sacrament, asked Jesus, why Five First Saturdays. Jesus said, “**My daughter, the reason is simple. There are five types of offenses committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary: Blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception, blasphemies against her perpetual virginity, blasphemies against her Divine Maternity, blasphemies of those who seek to sow in the hearts of children indifference or scorn, or even hatred of the Immaculate Mother and the offenses of those who outrage Her directly in Her holy images**”.

At the end of August 1931, Lucia was praying in the chapel of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Rianjo, Spain, for the conversion of Russia, Portugal and Spain. Jesus said to her, “**You console me a great deal by asking for conversion of those poor nations. Ask it also of My Mother, frequently praying, “Sweet heart of Mary, be the salvation of Russia, Spain, Portugal, Europe and the whole world. At other times pray, By thy pure and Immaculate Conception O Mary, obtain for Me, the conversion of Russia, Spain, Portugal, Europe and the whole world**”.

Jesus told Lucia, that He wanted devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, placed alongside devotion to His most Sacred Heart. He also referred to the message He gave St. Margaret Mary for King Louis XIV of France that was not heeded, “**Make it known to My ministers given that they follow the example of the King of France in delaying the execution of My**

**command, they will follow Him to misfortune. It will never be too late to have recourse to Jesus and Mary”.**

On the afternoon of 3 January 1944, Our Lady appeared to Lucia again in the convent chapel. On this occasion Lucia had a vision of the annihilation of the nations. “I felt my spirit flooded by a mystery of light that is God and in Him saw and heard: “The tip of the spear as a flame unlatches and touches the axis of the earth. It shudders. Mountains, villages, towns and villages with their inhabitants are buried. The sea, the rivers and the clouds emerge from their limits, overflowing and bringing with them a whirlwind of houses and people in numbers that are not possible to count. It is the purification of the world by sin as it plunges. Hatred and ambition cause the destructive war!” Then I felt a rapid beating of my heart and in my mind the echo of a gentle voice saying – in time, one faith, one baptism, one Church, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic. In eternity, Heaven!”

Pope St. John Paul said that the chastisement of the world can be mitigated by prayer.

### **Sister Lucia’s peace pledge**

Lucia was asked what must the individual catholic do to bring peace to the world and avert the annihilation of the nations. Lucia wrote a peace pledge for the world, asking people to make a promise to Our Lady:

Dear Queen and Mother, who promised at Fatima to convert Russia and bring peace to all mankind, in reparation to Your Immaculate Heart for my sins and the sins of the whole world, I solemnly promise:

- To offer up every day the sacrifices of my daily duty
- To pray 5 decades of the Rosary daily while meditating on the mysteries
- To wear the Scapular of Mount Carmel as a profession of this promise and as an act of consecration to You.
- To complete the five first Saturdays devotion as requested by the Child Jesus

St. Padre Pio said that if enough people fulfil this pledge, Our Lady will convert Russia and bring peace to the world. If you wish to sign up to the peace pledge, there are pledge cards

beside the large heart on the altar. A bouquet of roses will be presented to Our Lady in Fatima on 8 December on behalf of all who enrol.

### **Solemnity of St. Peter and St. Paul and Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of Mary**

The feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary immediately follows the feast of the Sacred Heart. From midnight we will pray in reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Today is also the Solemnity of St. Peter and St. Paul, and so mass will be for the Solemnity of St. Peter and St. Paul.

### **Prayer in honour of St. Peter and St. Paul**

Holy Apostles Peter and Paul, intercede for us. Guard your people, who rely on the patronage of your apostles Peter and Paul, O Lord, and keep them under your continual protection. Through Christ our Lord. Amen

When we pray this prayer we can gain a partial indulgence for a holy soul.

On the night before Herod was to try him, Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, fastened with double chains, while guards kept watch at the main entrance of the prison. Then suddenly the angel of the Lord stood there and the cell was filled with light. He tapped Peter on the side and woke him. ‘Get up’, he said, ‘Hurry!’ – and the chains fell from his hands. The Angel then said, ‘Put on your belt and sandals.’ After he had done this, the angel next said, ‘Wrap your cloak round you and follow me.’ Peter followed him, but had no idea that what the angel did was all happening in reality; he thought he was seeing a vision. They passed through two guard posts one after the other and reached the iron gate leading to the city. This opened of its own accord; they went through it and had walked the whole length of the street when suddenly the angel left him. It was only then that Peter came to himself. ‘Now I know it is all true’, he said. ‘The Lord really did send an angel and has saved me from Herod and from all that the Jewish people were so certain would happen me’.

## INDULGENCES

### Draw all the indulgences from The Treasury of the Church

Jesus said to St. Faustina, **“Bring to Me the Souls who are in the prison of Purgatory, and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy. Let the torrents of My blood cool down their scorching flames. All these souls are greatly loved by Me. They are making retribution to My justice. It is in your power to bring them relief. Draw all the indulgences from the Treasury of the Church and offer them on their behalf. Oh if you only knew the torments they suffer you would continually offer from them alms of the spirit and pay off their debt to My justice”.**

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due in atonement for sins already forgiven. An indulgence may be plenary or partial. A plenary indulgence removes all temporal punishment due to a soul, releasing the soul into heaven, a partial indulgence removes part of the temporal punishment due. A plenary indulgence can be received once a day, many partial indulgences can be gained once a day.

There are three conditions required attached to a plenary indulgence: sacramental confession, holy communion and prayers for the Holy Father to include an Our Father and Hail Mary. There are also plenary indulgences connected to a visit to a church, oratory or cemetery, when we are asked to pray the Creed and an Our Father. “If the faithful offer indulgences for the dead, they cultivate charity in an excellent way and

while raising their minds to heaven, they bring a wiser order into the things of this world”. (Pope St. Paul VI)

Those who earnestly help the holy souls will have great assistance themselves. “By that measure by which you measure, it will be measured to you again”.
